All schools

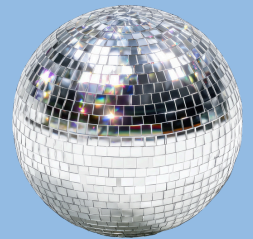
Thursday 12th February

please don't purchase anything new- upcycle dark clothing and add a tea towel for aprons...

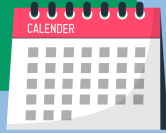
