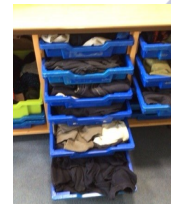

We loved having a visit from two police officers when we got to sit in the police car!</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we will sing our '5 little pumpkins' song using our fingers to help our understanding of how numbers can change. We will also scoop out our pumpkins.</p> 	<p><i>Reception</i></p> <p><b>Class 1 &amp; 2</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, we have experimented with colour mixing powder paints. The children have painted a self-portrait and have learned about the famous artist, Vincent Van Gogh</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we will be using an iPad to take and edit photographs and will also have a go at filming a video! As part of RE we will be thinking about how special events such as birthdays are celebrated and learning about the Hindu festival of Diwali.</p> 
<p><i>Year 1</i></p> <p><b>Class 3 &amp; 4</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, we have been learning to partition numbers 1 to 5 in a systematic way and record this on a part-whole model.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, in English we will be editing and improving our work. We will also be learning about 'Who celebrates Harvest?' in RE.</p> 	<p><i>Year 2</i></p> <p><b>Class 5 &amp; 6</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, we partitioned a number in maths. When adding <math>7 + 8</math> we partitioned the 8 into 5 and 3 so we could do <math>7 + 3</math> first to make 10 then <math>10 + 5</math> to make 15. Making a pair to ten first is an efficient way to add, rather than counting on in ones. Extra practise at home would be appreciated. Try these: <math>6 + 5</math>, <math>8 + 4</math>, <math>9 + 5</math>.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we will also be learning about what makes a Christian or Muslim person special in RE.</p> 	<p><i>Year 3</i></p> <p><b>Beech &amp; Chestnut Classes</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, in English we have been working hard to use a range of descriptive language to build an image in our readers mind, such as expanded noun phrases, our five senses and similes. We created some lovely Autumn simile poems.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we are looking forward to our RE day, focusing on exploring different texts for different faiths.</p> 
<p><i>Year 4</i></p> <p><b>Willow &amp; Holly Classes</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, we started planning and writing our adventure stories.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we look forward to celebrating the artwork we have created at our art exhibition. We also have our RE days next Thursday and Friday, the theme is Hinduism.</p> 	<p><i>Year 5</i></p> <p><b>Oak &amp; Ash Classes</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, we have been securing our rounding skills in maths and looking at inverted commas in English.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we will have our RE days and focus on Buddhism.</p> 	<p><i>Year 6</i></p> <p><b>Pine &amp; Sycamore Classes</b></p> <p><b>This week</b>, the non-Kingswood children engaged in a 'Calm day', 'Creative day', 'Cooking day', 'Sports day' and an 'Entertainment day'. Lots of games, lots to taste, lots of fun!</p> <p>Check out our Facebook for the wonderful things that the children at Kingswood have been doing.</p> <p><b>Next week</b>, we will be looking at Stories of Faith in RE.</p>
