Maths

This half term we will be learning to:

- subtract pairs of 2 and 3-digit numbers using column subtraction, with and without exchange, and solve subtraction problems
- use the terms 'minuend' (the number we are subtracting from) 'subtrahend' (the number we are subtracting) and 'difference' (the answer to a subtraction calculation)
- identify a wholes and parts including equal and unequal
- explain the size of a part in relation to the whole (eg 'This part is one fifth of the size of the whole because there are 5 equal parts in the whole.')
- use fraction notation to describe an equal part of the whole,
- compare and order unit fractions (fractions that are one part of a whole)
- identify parts and wholes in different contexts, eg fractions of shapes, quantities, measures and fractions on number lines
